Dear Friends,

One of my favourite television programmes is *Long Lost Family*, which aims to reunite family members who have been separated from each other, generally since birth or early childhood. With a team of background researchers and social workers, presenters Davina McCall and Nicky Campbell meet people who are crying out to know their own stories and to be reunited with siblings, mothers, fathers, sons and daughters whom they may never have known. There are extraordinary and painful stories of family separation, citing extra-marital childbirth, parental pressure, extreme poverty, homelessness, broken marriages, acrimonious divorces, heart-rending decisions, poor physical or mental health, to mention just some of the causes.

It generally takes the determination - and feeling of lostness - of just one person to set the ball in motion for relatives to be identified, found and ultimately reunited. Not everyone wishes to relive painful memories or to question the motives of parents or grandparents but, where long lost families are brought together there can be inexpressible joy and a sense of belonging that they may have craved for decades. I might even detect a tear or two rolling down my face as I watch an emotional reunion!

Why have I used two paragraphs to tell you what you may already know? It's because I am reminded of the broken relationship between human beings and God that He longs to mend. God, our heavenly Father, has already taken the initiative by sending His Son Jesus to rescue us from the sin that separates us and to welcome us into the family. It is such good news that we should be telling it to everyone we meet. That includes people with learning disabilities. They are as lost as anyone and everyone else. Some of them may have never known their human families and that is sad, very sad. But, they can know their heavenly Father and become His children. That means that we are brothers and sisters, one big family. Let's love, care for and appreciate one another.




